INTROIT: Psalm 145:1-14.

P The LORD is good to all. His compassion is over all that He has made.

C **All whom You have made will praise You, O LORD. Your devout people will bless You.**

P They will talk about the glory of Your Kingdom and speak about Your power.

C **In order to make known to the descendants of Adam the mighty things that He has done, and the glorious grandeur of His kingdom.**

P Your kingdom is an everlasting kingdom. Your dominion endures throughout all generations.

C The LORD is faithful in all His works, and gracious in all His deeds.

All The LORD supports all those who are falling. He raises up all who are bowed down.

Be our strength and support amid the wearisome changes of this world, and at life's end grant us Your promised rest and the full joys of Your salvation; through Jesus Christ, Your Son, our Lord, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever.

No one knows the Son except the Father, and no one knows the Father except the Son and the one to whom the Son wishes to reveal Him.

28 **“Come to Me, all you who are working hard and carrying a heavy burden; and I shall give you rest! 29** Take My yoke on you and learn from Me! For I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. **30** For My yoke is easy, and My burden is light.”

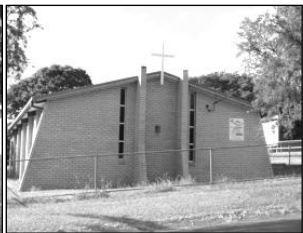
