When Christians partake of the Lord's Supper in a church body that has a confession of faith, they thereby declare that they believe that they are one in faith with those who commune with them. Gay Men's Choir Sings "We'll Convert Your Children"

The battle lines are being drawn more clearly each day in our western nations. The devil is coming after our children through the schools, media, streaming platforms, various political leaders, courts, and even some churches!

A couple weeks ago, the San Francisco gay men's choir published a video in which they sing, "We'll convert your children... we're coming for your children." And no, that's not an exaggeration - that's word-for-word what they repeated throughout the song.

The video is now private, and some people are claiming it was meant as satire or a joke. But there is no indication in the original post or in the song itself that it was intended as a satirical joke - and even if it was, it's what they actually believe! Besides, actual satirical sites will usually state what they post is satire. Here are some of the lyrics:

You think we're sinful. You fight against our rights. You say we all lead lives you can't respect. But you're just frightened. You think that we'll corrupt your kids if our agenda goes unchecked. It's funny. Just this once, you're correct.

We'll convert your children. Happens bit by bit. Quietly and subtly, and you will barely notice it. You can keep him from disco, warn about San Francisco. Make him wear pleated pants. We don't care. We'll convert your children. We'll make them tolerant and fair.

They repeat the words "we'll convert your children" and "we're coming for your children" over and over again.

Many people have pointed out that LGBT activists originally said they just wanted equal rights and that it's "none of your business what two adults do in the bedroom" - and now, just a few short years later, these activists are singing about converting children, purposefully undermining the morality instilled in them by their parents.

The Word of God warns us about this: "*Be self-controlled and alert! Your enemy, the Devil, is prowling around like a roaring lion, looking for someone to devour*" (1 Peter 5:8). And be reminded, "*For the LORD gives wisdom. Knowledge and understanding come from His mouth... to deliver you from any evil way, from anyone who speaks perverse things,* ¹³ *from people who abandon straight paths to walk on dark ways,* ¹⁴ *from people who enjoy doing evil, from people who rejoice in the perversity of evil,* ¹⁵ *from people whose*

paths are crooked and who are devious in their ways” (Proverbs 2:6, 12–15).

Fathers, be the head and lead your family as God commanded. The world is out to capture our children with perverse ideologies. We must train up our children in the nurture and admonition of the Lord so they won’t get captured by the philosophies of our day.

Elephant Trunks - More Complicated Than We Thought

Evolutionists can’t explain the complex design and usefulness of the elephant trunk, but Christians know who made it.

Elephants use their incredibly dexterous trunks almost like a hand with fingers. This trunk boasts around 40,000 individual muscles and can be used to suck up food and water. But the elephant’s trunk isn’t just a “simple straw” - and new research shows it’s more complicated than was initially thought.

A recent study detailed measurements during one zoo elephant’s feeding time. They discovered the elephant can “dilate its nostrils to boost its trunk’s carrying capacity.” Each of an elephant’s two nostrils can increase in volume by a stunning 64%! The “flow rate of water through the trunk averaged about 3.7 litres per second, or the equivalent of the amount of water pouring out of 24 shower heads at once.”

But the elephant doesn’t always need this extra space. They actually have the ability to “vacuum” up their food by breathing deeply. They estimate “that airflow through the narrow nostrils could at times exceed 150 metres per second - more than 30 times as fast as a human sneeze.”

Sadly, the researchers give credit for this incredible trunk to random chance processes over millions of years, saying that “elephants are the only living land animals to evolve a long, boneless appendage like a trunk.” But this complex appendage isn’t the result of evolution - it clearly showcases the brilliancy of God’s handiwork. As we say here, it’s designed to do what it does do! It’s a reminder of Romans chapter 1: *“For his invisible attributes, namely, his eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly perceived, ever since the creation of the world, in the things that have been made. So they are without excuse” (Romans 1:20).*

The more we look into what God’s made, the more we realize how little we know and how amazing our Creator God is!
